### ADMISSION:

- Parents should note that the date of birth entered in the school records will remain the same throughout the academic career of the student.
- Original birth certificate and a photo copy thereof, have to be submitted along with the application for admission.
- Applications for admission should be made in the prescribed form and should be submitted along with the Transfer Certificate from the school last attended. Every pupil on admission shall pay the prescribed fee.
- Only those who have completed five and half years by May are eligible for admission to class 1. No relaxation in this regard will be made. Parents should note that the date of birth entered in the school records will remain the same throughout the academic career of the student.
- Re-application should be submitted to the school while admitting class 6 and 9 with required documents (Old students).

### FEE (TUITION AND TRANSPORT):

All fees must be paid as indicated at the beginning of each academic year. Any delay in the payment of fee will attract a fine. If a child remains absent from school for more than a fortnight without informing the school, his/her name be withdrawn from the school and re –admission fee will be charged for further entry.

- Tuition fee is be paid in lump sum or in two instalments.
- Fee once paid will not be returned irrespective of whether the child has attended the school or not. In case of withdrawal during midterm, the next instalment of tuition fees and bus fees will be charged.
  - Cost of uniform, books, stationary, Annual Day and outdoor camps will be additional.
  - · School fees may be increased every year.
  - Late fee is charged for to defaultaries and is at the discretion of the management.

### **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

- Students are expected to be on time to school every day. Regular attendance and punctuality to school is emphasized on.
- Care should be taken of the school property. Students are liable to make good all the damages they cause to school property.
  - Books must be brought to school according to the daily schedule.
- Bags, shoes, other articles brought to school should have the name of the students' and class marked on them.
- Property found on the premises may be handed over to the school office. Students should take good care of their belongings. The school is not to be responsible for money or articles or any other valuables lost in the school premises. Pupils are held responsible for their belongings.
- Mobile phones or other electronic gadgets are strictly prohibited in the school for students. Students found using the mobile phones will be accountable for the consequences. The confiscated phone will be returned to the parents with fine.
- Students are prohibited from bringing cameras, CDs, I Pads, Slam Books, Picture Magazines, Comics, Video Games, Audio Tapes and changing of clothes or shoes without specific permission from the Principal.
- Students will not be exempted from PE or Games unless a valid doctor's certificate accompanied by the parent appeal is submitted to and approved by the principal.
- Students are discouraged from offering presents to their teachers except those sanctioned by the principal.
- Any correspondence with the school should be addressed to the principal, the full name of the child along with the class and section should be mentained.
- The school though not responsible for the conduct of the students outside its premises will take cognizance of any serious misconduct committed outside the school.
- No pupil is allowed to leave the school premises during the school hours without the permission of the principal.
- On the teacher's arrival in the class-room the pupils must rise and remain standing till they greeted the teacher and then take their seats.

- No pupil should absent himself/herself from answering any class tests/examinations/activities except for medical reasons. Medical Certificate should be produced to claim re-examinations.
- Complaints/grievances/concerns of any nature have to be addressed in writing in the prescribed format to the principal.
  - Books, umbrellas etc. should have a name or mark by which the owner can easily identify them.
- Children are not permitted to bring toys, fancy stationery, games materials to school. The same will be confiscated and won't be returned.
  - Involvement of any type of malpractice during tests and examinations will be dealt with seriously.
  - Chewing gum on the campus and inside the class is treated as punishable offence.
- Students are not allowed to collect money from other students for any purpose without the permission of the principal.

### **SCHOOL BUS:**

- All the students shall use facility on payment of bus fee, provided the desired bus stop is on the routes decided by the school.
  - The bus will ply in accordance with the existing routes without any deviation whatsoever.
- The child/children should be present at the respective stops 10 minutes before being picked up. The bus will not wait for the child/children who turn up late.
- It is the responsibility of the parents to see that the children are made to board the school bus and escort home on the way back from the respective bus stop. If there is no one at the bus stop to pick up the child (Pre Primary to class 1 in particular) on the return trip the parent will have to collect the child form the bus.
- A bus fee has to be paid in three equal instalments. A child can opt not to avail bus facility after the tenure of the service of the paid instalment completes.
- Children are expected to follow the rules and regulations as imposed by the school authorities as and when required. Standing while the bus in motion, drinking and eating in the bus and throwing waste paper and empty cans either inside the bus or on the road is prohibited. Unruly and unbecoming behaviour in the bus is liable to disciplinary action.
- Parents are advised not to enter the school buses and also not to have altercation/arguments with the duty personnel. Any complaints may please be directed to the Principal.

### ATTENDENCE:

- Regular attendance in class is a condition for promotion. A student will not be promoted to the next higher class if his/her attendance falls below 75%.
- Promotion is based on a total performance in the tests and exams for attendance. The school conducts examination on regular basis so as to remove fear, stress and strain in the children.
- Punctual and regular attendance is insisted upon. No leave of absence is granted except on prior written application from parents/guardian in the form provided in the dairy. If the absence exceed 3 days, notice must be forwarded to the principal.
- When a pupil is absent from school without leave for some reason not foreseen e.g., illness, she/he must on returning to school, bring a note of excuse from her/his parents/guardian in the form provided in the diary. Support document i.e. Medical/fitness certificate must be produced to the Principal.
- Leave or absence from school even for a few periods for attending social functions or religious ceremonies is strictly not allowed.
  - Parents are not permitted to take their child out of school during term time or extend holidays.
  - Attendance is compulsory on school re-opening, closing day as well as on all national festivals.

### **SCHOOL DIARY:**

- Students are expected to bring the diary daily to school.
- This diary is a link between the teachers and the parents. Parents are requested to refer it daily to keep in touch with their ward's progress.
- Parents should read and sign the message sent to them from time to time. They should keep an eye on the attendance and leave record.
- If the diary is lost, a duplicate diary has to be bought by paying Rs.100/- and get it signed by the principal. If the original diary is found later, that must be submitted to the principal.

### SCHOOL UNIFORM:

- Students are expected to come in their school uniform, neatly pressed and clean.
- Wearing bindi, jewellery, mehandi, flower and other accessories to school is not permitted. This is done so as to ensure simplicity and uniformity amongst the students.

- Girl students are not allowed to wear long mufta. It should simple and short as per the school rule.
- A pair of simple earrings, preferably studs may be worn to school every day.
- All children are expected to wear the school Identity Card every day.
- The prescribed footwear is well polished black gola shoes and black socks (half white stripe). However, black belted sandal is allowed during the rainy season.
- Girls have to wear black tights (class 1 and 2)and petticoats and boys vests compulsorily. Pinafore should be knee length (class 1 and 2 girls). Girls and boys from class 6 to 10 to wear waist coat.
- Boys must wear pants above their waist and it should cover their heels (class 2 to 10). They are expected to wear the school belt.
- Girls with shoulder length hair should tie their hair in two pony tails and longer length should be formed in two plaits. The plaits may be tied up using a black ribbon. No fancy clips or coloured ribbons will be allowed except black ribbons or black clips.
- Boys are expected to have regular haircut which has to be simple and short (not too long and not too short or complete shave).
  - Colouring of hair and use of gel or spiking is strictly prohibited.
  - Students will be sent home if failed to follow any of school dress code.
- Students need to be in full school uniform when they are coming for the open house, collection of hall tickets and any other school related work.
- The girl students are allowed to apply mehandi twice in an academic year but they should avoid nails, upper part of palm, and arm. In case of wedding function at home, the students should pay Rs.100/- in advance to get the permission to apply mehandi (fine should be paid in office)
  - Girl students are not allowed to wear long mufthas. It should be simple and short as per the school rule.

### A NOTE TO PARENTS

- The school expects full co-operation of the parents and guardians in all matters concerning the education of their child. Parents are to read the school diary every evening and see to it that the lessons and homework's assigned for the next day is done.
  - It is important that you make note of the remarks made in the diary by the principal or the teacher and to sign.

- Please encourage the child to dress neatly to school, keep their personal belongings carefully, polish shoes, make their own bed and take pride in their work.
  - Please ensure that you follow the school reheduse . Avoid other gathering during school days.
- Any form of criticism of the teacher or the school in the presence of the students is to be strictly avoided. If done, the students loose the respect for his/her teacher and fail to learn from the teacher or the school. If there is a genuine problem, it is advisable to contact the Principal.
  - Parents are requested to visit the school for all their transactions only during office hours on working days.
  - Parents visiting the school on a working day must go to the front office and not to the staff or classrooms.
- All the coordinators and subject teachers are available to meet the parent at the school on Saturdays between 9.30 am and 12.00 noon. The parents who wish to meet the principal should do so with a prior appointment.
  - Attendance is compulsory on school re-opening, closing day as well as on all national festivals.
- The date of birth and other details of the student (as per the birth certificate of the student) entered in the school records will remain the same throughout the academic career of the student.
- The child must be picked from school by father or mother only. If other family member or non-family member has to take charge of the child then a formal letter addressed to the principal must be sent furnishing the details.
- No pupil should absent himself/herself from answering any class tests/examinations/activities except for medical reasons. Medical Certificate should be produced to claim re-examinations.
- In change in name, date of birth, change in address, telephone number, child's stop or any other entries should be brought to the notice of the school immediately.
- Without parents request, the school won't take any initiative/move to sent the children to some other place other than already given place.
- Parents are expected to duly sing the class test papers and look after the progress of their wards. Attending interactive sessions as well as other important school functions is the duty of all parents, when invited.
- Students need to be in full school uniform when they are coming for the open house, collection of hall tickets and any other school related work.
- Parents are not allowed to take their children home in the middle of school hours. students once enterd are allowed to go out only after the duration of school. School will send the children home in case of health issue only with the permission of parents.
  - Parents are requested to co-operate with the school authorities in matters of discipline and other school system.
